Don't Forget:

- Bring a labeled tub/basket for all of your personal belongs to stay organized in the dressing rooms.
- Dressing Rooms & Backstage areas have to be cleared after each show. Your personal belongings can stay but make plans to leave the theater area after shows & return at your designated call times.
- Spend some time mapping out your schedule for each show and planing your costumes and quick changes. Immediately after each show, plan to clean-up your dressing room area, re-hang costumes, organize your dance shoes and accessories, and pick-up/drop-off costumes in the quick change area. These tasks should be complete before you take a break between shows.
- Call time for each show is 90 minutes prior to show time. This is your only time to mark spacing with your classes, so please pay attention to the time and don't be late for each show (you will have approx. 45 mins-1 hour for a break between the end of each show and your next call time). Once your classes mark spacing on stage you will be able to relax in the dressing room/snack/etc.
- Stretch between each show to stay warm and ready to take the stage.
- Fuel-up for success! Proteins, Carbs, and snacks that pack a punch will keep you energized through the long day. Try to drink at least a full bottle of water for every show! Breaks between shows are short - plan meals for each break ahead of time.
- Shower some love on your Company Families! Good Luck cards, Showcase Care Packages, Love Notes... be creative and have fun.
- You are powerful! You have worked so hard for this week. Enjoy every moment, support each other, make new memories, have fun, and let us know what you need. We believe in you! We can't wait to find you under the lights, diamonds under your eyes... and watch you dance the night away!
